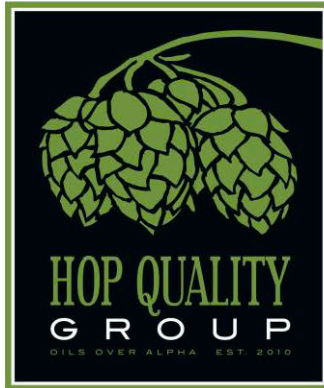

**Operations Description**

40 year-year-old farm. 1100 total acres, with 22 varieties on 20-30 acre plots. Former Haas Facility.
Dauenhauer picker. Hops are dried at 130-135°F and data is collected and entered for every kiln.
Recently converted to diesel. Shatterproof lighting in all rooms. Clearly marked extinguishers.
Good pest management system controlled by traps.
